Small Non-Profit Fund-Raising Activities

Temporary fund raising sales by tax exempt organizations pursuant to 501(c) of the federal Internal Revenue Code are allowed in non-residential zones with the permission of the land owner(s) of the site where the activity will take place so long as the total area within which the activity will occur does not exceed one thousand (1,000) square feet; all applicable laws and regulations are followed (including regulations and ordinances that may be enforced by other County departments such as Public Works, Building, and Environmental Management); and there is no disruption to the normal circulation of the site; no encroachment upon driveways, pedestrian walkways, or required parking or landscaped areas; no obstruction to sight distances; and no other hazard created for vehicle or pedestrian traffic. Examples of the types of temporary activities that may be exempted from the Temporary Use Permit requirement under this section include cookie and bake sale stands, manual car wash fundraisers, and ticket sales by non-profits, schools, or other charitable organizations.
